RECOMMENDED SUPPLY LIST:

Please bring tubes of watercolor (I much prefer tubes to pan). A variety of colors.

Cold press watercolor paper (minimum size: 9 x 12). I love Arches brand (it is the best quality), but Canson and other brands are fine too.

Watercolor brushes in a variety of points (flat, fine tip, wide tip) - Windsor & Newton is excellent, Please avoid buying super cheap watercolor brushes as the hairs will fall out when you paint. It's worth spending a little more on this.

Watercolor pencils - a variety of colors.

White gouache - or Chinese White watercolor paint.
